Small Business Association Invites Entrepreneurs to March Meetings To Network & Learn

Courtenay, BC—The Comox Valley Small Business Association (SBA), is hosting a meeting on Thursday, March 3. Owners of small businesses are invited to attend as guests.

The meeting is held the Filberg Center, lower level (Evergreen Room), and starts at 5:30 pm. There will be networking from 5:30-6, and then the educational portion of the meeting starts and runs until 7pm.

The guest speaker will be attorney Wayne Anderson, partner in Anderson & Co. Barrister & Solicitor. He will speak about pros and cons of incorporation, and how it compares to sole proprietorships and partnerships.

Guests should bring business cards for the networking portion of the meeting; they are invited to bring a door prize and a snack to share.

The organization's March 17th meeting, also at the Filberg Center, will include networking, a spotlight presentation by Carmie Dixon of Relay Event Rentals. There will also be a "mastermind" session, which promotes a "group-think" approach to addressing business scenarios often faced by entrepreneurs.
